### How to play SENET

- Roll a dice to see who goes first (highest number goes first).
- Roll a dice to see how many squares to move your piece forward (follow direction of arrows).
- If you roll a 6, roll again after moving your game piece and reading a card. You get another turn.
- During your turn, you may not land on the same square as one of your own pieces. However, you may not switch if she or he has two or more pieces touching in a row. This forms a block.
- If you land on the other player's piece, switch places. Choose another game piece to move.
- Some squares are "safe" squares and one is a "bounce" square. When you are on a safe square, you do not have to switch that piece with anyone else. If you land on the bounce square, you have to move back to any open space on either the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> rows.
- When you land on a **SM**, **E**, or **I** square, draw the corresponding card to read about **Social Media**, **Elections** or **International** issues. Read your card aloud - each person should add brief notes to his/her note sheet.
- You don't need an exact roll to move off the board. The first player to move all pieces off the board wins! Continue to play even if you read all cards. If a player moves all pieces off before all cards are read, finish reading all cards.
